Exchange Policy: Tickets will not be held in advance for exchange. Exchanges are only available for productions with multiple performances. If you need to exchange tickets, please mail your tickets to Wharton Center: Attn. Ticket Office and indicate which performance(s) you would like to exchange. When we have received your tickets, we will seat you in the best available seats for the new performance. If you are moving to a night that is more expensive, you will need to include a method of payment with your returned tickets. If your new tickets are lower in price, the difference will be applied as a non tax-deductible donation to Wharton Center.

Seating Policy: Every effort is made to start performances at the announced hour unless there is an unavoidable delay. For the consideration of our patrons and performers, anyone arriving while a performance is in progress will be seated only at times designated by the artist and their management. Late arriving patrons may be directed to seats in the rear of the theatre until intermission.

Restoration Fee: Wharton Center has implemented a \$2.50 restoration fee on each ticket sold for every performance. This fee, common in the industry, will be charged on all tickets sold, not just Wharton Center events. In so doing, all guests who enjoy performances at any of the facilities under the Wharton Center's management will participate in maintaining these state-of-the-art facilities.

Children Policy: Infants and newborns are not permitted. Everyone attending must have a ticket and be able to sit in a seat. Children under 5 years of age are not permitted unless otherwise advertised. Parents will be asked to remove their child/children if they are causing disruptions or are unable to sit quietly.

Cameras & Recording Devices: Cameras, including mobile device cameras, and other recording devices (audio, video and still) are not permitted in the theatre and may be confiscated if used during a performance. If brought into the facility, cameras may be checked in at the Patron Services Desk in the Sierra Lobby.

Cell Phone and Personal Electronic Device Policy: The use of cell phones and other electronic devices is strictly prohibited. Cellular phones and other devices can cause distractions to performers and other patrons and will be confiscated. Please turn all devices off!

Audio Description: A FM receiver provides access to the program notes as well as a descriptive narration of the visual elements of a performance to blind and visually impaired patrons. This service is available for Sunday matinee performances of Broadway shows when requested a minimum of four weeks in advance.

Sign Language Interpretation: Sign Language interpreters enable patrons who are deaf to perceive spoken theatrical content. This service is available for Sunday matinee performances of Broadway shows when requested a minimum of four weeks in advance.

Assisted Listening Devices: Phonic Ear headsets are available from the Patron Services desk located across from Wharton Gifts.

Barrier-Free Parking: Available on all levels of the Wharton Center ramp. Wharton Center entrance (level 2) is accessible by elevator from any level.

Wheelchair pick-up: Available for most performances when requested in advance. Wheelchair pick-up at Wharton Center is available on level 2, Shaw Lane entrance ONLY.

Open Captioning: A text display provides a simultaneous translation of dialogue and lyrics during a live performance, for patrons with any level of hearing loss. This service is available for select Thursday evening performances of Broadway shows.
